

PLAYGROUND RULES

Year 3/4

We want you to enter school calm and ready for learning, to help we have changed some of the rules.

Before school

All play equipment will be in school.

Children will walk and spend time chatting with friends rather than chasing each other.

The trim trail is for play and lunchtimes only.

When wet please keep on the playground not on the grass, this helps keep you and the school clean.

Once a member of staff is on the playground parents can leave.

When the bell is rung, stand still and wait to be told to line up quickly and quietly.

To help children's independence parents are encouraged to allow their children to line up on their own.



Play/lunch time

Keep to the main playground, not behind the wall or in the quiet area.

The equipment monitors will put equipment out and put it away.

There will be a year group rota for the trim trails.

All games must be non-contact.

Ask an adult if you need to go to the toilet, otherwise stay outside.

When wet please keep on the playground not on the grass, this helps keep you and the school clean.
