As part of our Romans topic next term, we would like to take the children to the 'Roman Baths' in the City of Bath on **Thursday 21st March**. The day will enrich the children's learning and bring over 2,000 years of history to life. Whilst this is an exciting and valuable activity for the children it cannot be considered essential, therefore we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £20.44. This includes the coach, guided activities and a tour around the ancient site. This contribution can be paid online via ParentPay or through cash at the School Office. We appreciate your contributions and hope to receive sufficient funds to enable this trip to go ahead.

Please send your child in with a packed lunch, in a paper/disposable bag, unless your child is eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). This saves the children having to carry lunchboxes around with them afterwards. If your child is eligible for FSM and you wish for them to have a packed lunch, please let us know.

We will travel by coach leaving school after registration and will arrive back for the end of the school day. Children are expected to wear their normal school uniform. Due to the location of the Roman Baths, the coach will stop approximately a 5 minute walk from the site and we will walk to the main entrance. Please therefore, ensure your child has a raincoat if needed.
