**Year 5 Secondary School Experience Day at SWR**

Each year, all Year 5 pupils are invited to attend Sir William Romney's for a day of 'secondary school experience'. This year the event will take place on **Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June**, within normal school hours.

The children will experience a variety of lessons and will be well looked after by a team of teachers and Year 8 students who will support them during the day. Your child should either bring a packed lunch, or food and drink can be purchased from the cafeteria (£2 will be sufficient). If your child qualifies for a Free School Meal, the kitchen will provide a packed lunch (please supply a drink).

Children should come to school as normal and after registration, will walk up to SWR accompanied by St Mary's staff. Teachers will then collect the children at the end of the day, so they are able to leave St Mary's at the normal school time.

**Parents have also been invited to visit the school at any time between 9.30am and midday. It has been suggested that you allow an hour for the visit, when you will be given a tour of the school. This will give you a chance to see the school at work during a normal day.**
