End of term arrangements

It is hard to believe that we are fast approaching the end of the academic year and your child will be leaving St Mary's, to start a new stage of their learning journey, at secondary school. Leaving primary school is an exciting and significant point in a child's life. The Year 6 children will also be spending their induction days at Sir William Romney's and Malmesbury School as well as Marling, Stroud High School and Thomas Keble. Please contact the office if you need dates for these but you should have heard directly from the schools.

This year, the leavers have chosen to go to Bowood House and Gardens for a final treat. This will take place during school time, Wednesday 18th July. You should have had a letter and replied by now to give them permission and your contribution. We have been donated the cost of the coach journey there by the PTFA and Year 6 will raise the remainder – details to follow. They have also organised **leavers' hoodies** for the children to purchase – we will be giving them to the children in the last week of term. They can wear them in school as soon as they have received them.

On <u>Friday 20th July</u> we will be holding a special end of term service in the hall at 1.30pm when we will be presenting various awards and celebrating our Year 6 Leavers. All Year 6 parents are invited to attend this service.

I hope that with the combination of all these events, the children will have a memorable send off from St. Mary's and an exciting and action packed end to the Summer Term.
