



Maths

We will be working on recognising larger numbers and understanding the place value within them. We will calculate one more and one less than numbers and compare numbers. We will practice counting in 2s and 5s and develop subtraction skills.

Religious Education

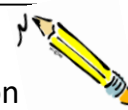
This term the Christian Value we will focus on is 'Forgiveness'. In RE the children will learn about the Easter story and consider how 'new life' is relevant to this time of year for Christians.

Music

We will be singing songs and exploring the sounds that instruments make. We will be introduced to informal notation of music, the idea that marks on paper can tell us what to play!

English

Children will be continuing to work on their basic literacy skills, using their phonic knowledge to read and write. We will be writing for different purposes this term, sequencing a story, writing diary entries and writing instructions. The children will be encouraged to say their sentences aloud before writing them.



Science

We will learn about plants, naming their parts. We will think about the changes over the seasons.

History

We will talk about local traditions such as the 'Woolsack' and 'Wacky Races' in Tetbury Town.

Computing

The children will work on the Purple Mash website, using their own passwords to log in and exploring grouping and sorting.

PSHE

This term we focus on 'Healthy Me!', discussing how to make healthy choices and how to stay safe. We will think about road safety and how to stay safe with medicines.

Art & Design

We will also have a creative Easter 'carousel' morning where the children will engage in a variety of craft activities. We will be using paint and collage techniques to recreate some of the artwork from 'The Tiny Seed' book.

PE

The children will continue their weekly 'Balanceability' sessions and regular handwriting sessions. In PE lessons the children will develop basic skills as we create obstacle courses designed to encourage balancing and travelling skills.
