Literacy

We will be continuing to develop our reading and writing skills through RWI each day. We will be looking at Non-fiction books, creating story maps, writing instructions and recipes. We will be spending time learning about sentences and simple punctuation.

We will be retelling stories and rhymes as well as talking about our own experiences in group activities. The children will develop their vocabulary as they learn about different countries and engage in 'Travel Agent' role play.

Religious Education

This term our Christian value is 'Forgiveness'. In RE the children will think about special people in their lives, and how Jesus was special. The children will also learn about the Easter story towards the end of the term.

Understanding the World

We will be finding out about different parts of the world, and a range of environments. We will investigate where different countries are and what it is like to live there. Children will also experience how to find out information using books, technology and asking questions.

We will sing some new songs and play musical instruments. The children will have an African drumming experience. We will also have a creative Easter 'carousel' morning where the children will engage in a variety of craft activities. There will be opportunities to make models with recycled materials, to paint and express themselves through different media.
