Problem Solving throughout Maths



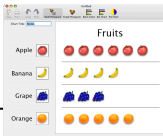
English

We will be reading the stories of 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'The Little Gardener Wild'. We will be writing about the stories and the children will further develop their understanding of different punctuation.



Computing

The children will learn how to write algorithms and debug basic instructions. They will be using beebots & code.org



Religious Education

In RE this term our key question is 'What do Christians believe God is like?' We will be looking at the story of 'Jonah and the Whale' and the 'Parable of the Lost Son' to show us how Christians see God as a loving and forgiving father.



Science

We will be looking at how plants grow by planting different seeds and bulbs. The children will find out what plants need to grow and be healthy. They will also learn about what each part of the plant is called and its function.



PSHE

We will be thinking about "why it is good to be me." The children will be looking at different emotions and feelings and how they deal with them. They will be celebrating things they are good at and we will be completing activities linked to Safer internet day in February.

Geography

The children will be devising simple maps and using basic symbols to plan a garden / allotment. The children will also learn compass points and learn directional language



Music

We will be using instruments to create layers of sound and exploring dynamics. The children will also be using their voices to explore and imitate sounds.

Art

In art this term we will be learning about colour mixing and focussing on creating a spectrum of shades using paint.

P.E.

The children will be learning gymnastic and ball skills to help their flexibility and coordination.
