Maths

This term we will be learning how to multiply and divide. We will be looking at the inverse relationships between the two. We will be learning how to tell the time to the hour, half past, quarter past and quarter to the hour. Children will continue to practise their mental Maths skills each week.

English

Our text this term is "The Enormous Turnip." We will be learning the text using actions, the children will be learning how to use contractions, add suffixes and use prepositional language. They will write their own newspaper report recounting the events that happened during the story.



OIVISION

Religious Education

In RE this term our key question is 'What do Christians believe God is like?' We will be looking at the story of 'Jonah and the Whale' and the 'Parable of the Lost Son' to show us how Christians see God as a loving and forgiving father.



Science

This term we will be looking at all the things a plant needs to grow and be healthy. We will be thinking about the different parts of a plant and what they are for. We will also be going outside on a tree hunt!



We will be thinking about "why it is good to be me." The children will be looking at different emotions and feelings and how they deal with them. They will be celebrating things they are good at and we will be completing activities linked to Safer internet day in February.



The children will be devising simple maps and using basic symbols to plan a garden / allotment. The children will also learn compass points and learn directional language

PE

We will be continuing with a range of PE skills both indoor and outdoor, across gymnastics, dance and games.

Computing

The children will learn how to write algorithms and debug basic instructions. They will be using beebots & code.org

ART

In art this term we will be learning about colour mixing and focussing on creating a spectrum of shades using paint.
