

Maths

We will be continuing to explore addition and subtraction. The children will also be continuing to reinforce their number formation and direction. The children will continue to learn about shape, space and measure once a week to help them to retain information such as time, capacity etc.

English

Children will be encouraged to extend their writing, focussing on using words such as 'and', 'because', 'when', and 'if' to extend sentences. We will be reading Rapunzel and other fairy tale related stories to help broaden our vocabulary.



Science

We will identify a variety of animals. We will use language such as carnivore, herbivore and omnivore when discussing animals eating preferences and vertebrate and invertebrate when identifying their structures.

Religious Education

We will be studying the theme of Incarnation and asking the question 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?'

PSHE

In PSHE we will be celebrating our differences, and understanding that they make us unique and special.

Computing

The children will be learning about algorithms and how they are implemented by using beebots. The children will then be able to use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programmes.



History

The children will be learning about events beyond living memory. These will include the Gunpowder Plot and Remembrance. We will be studying the story 'Where the poppies now grow' in more detail and using Art and DT to make objects related to these themes.



Physical Education

The children will be developing their Fundamental movement skills including balancing, throwing, catching and co-ordination. We will also be using movements to represent fireworks.
