Maths

This term we will be revising all that we have learned in Y2 and making sure children are secure in their learning. We will be looking at time to the hour, half past, and in 5 minute intervals. The children will also be continuing practising their 2, 5 and 10 times tables and associated division facts.

Religious Education

What does it mean to belong to a faith community? We will be looking at Christian, Muslim and Jewish symbols of belonging, as well as their baptism and weddings.

Computing

This term we will be working on different ways to present ideas such as quizzes, stories and leaflets.

PSHE

This term our focus is 'Changing Me'. We will look at how everyone is unique and special and how our bodies change since being a baby.

English

This term we will really focus on getting the children prepared for Y3. We will also use the story 'Oliver and the Seawigs' by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre to create wonderful writing in a range of genres.

Art

This term we will be creating collages of under the sea creatures.



This term we will be looking at seaside locations and their features. We will be looking at the impact of pollution on our oceans. We will also be identifying countries in the world.

Science

This term we will be learning some more about habitats and food chains within these habitats. We will also look at how animals adapt to their habitats. Some of this work will be closely linked to our geography unit.

Music

This term we will be using instruments to create under the sea inspired musical compositions with lyrics.
