



Maths

We will be continuing to work with addition and subtraction, place value, and shape, space and measure this term. This will involve developing our skills through practical activities, securing our skills with specific tasks, and problem solving to deepen our understanding.

Religious Education

This term the Christian Value we will focus on is '**Courage**'. We will think about what this means and how we can show it in everyday life. In RE we will learn about salvation and what Easter means to Christians with Mrs Pockett.

Music

To link in with our PSHE topic, we will be identifying ways to relax and using relaxing music to help keep our minds healthy.

English

This term we are studying the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. The children will be retelling the story through story maps and then innovating (changing) the story to produce their own versions. We will also look at non-fiction texts to help us to grow our own seeds, looking closely at the language used in instructional writing.



Science

We will continue to observe changes across the 4 seasons and look in more detail at the structure of common house plants and the types of common wild and garden plants.

History

The children will find out about significant historical events to our local area such as the Woolsack races.

Computing

The children will work on the Purple Mash website, using their own passwords to log in. We will also be exploring the Seesaw app on the iPads, now it has gone live!

PSHE
