Our topic this term is 'Home and Away' and we will be using the story Wild by Emily Hughes to base our English lessons on. In Science we will be exploring animals in more detail, particularly forest animals, identifying their structures and comparing them to other animals. We have already been ordering animals according to their characteristics to help us identify its type e.g. bird, mammal, fish, or amphibian.
