## English



This term we are studying the story of Wild by Emily Hughes. We will use the story to investigate landscapes and animals around the world. We will also look at non-fiction texts to help us to identify the features and habitats of animals around the world.

## Science

We will look in more detail at classifying types of animals and whether they are carnivores, omnivores or herbivores. We will also be identifying the different structures of animals.

## Geography

We will be identifying the seven continents and five oceans of our world. We will also be looking at our local environment and comparing it to somewhere else in the world.

## Religious Education

This term the Christian Value we will focus on is 'friendship'. We will think about what this means and how we can show it in everyday life. In RE we will learn about the Gospel and what the good news is that Jesus brings with Mrs Pockett.
