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# Take One Pícture

## WELCOME BACK

Welcome back to school. We hope that you have had a restful break and are feeling ready for Term 2. This term our topic is called 'Take One Picture'. We will look at one picture, which will create discussion and help us investigate the following question: **How did the Great Fire change London?** 

In Maths, we will be focusing on developing our addition and subtraction skills.
