

English



We will start by studying the traditional Anglo-Saxon tale of Beowulf. After orally retelling the story in their own words, the children will create their own traditional tales. The story will also be the basis for a class debate and the children will create balanced arguments from this.



Maths



The term will start with the children working on their knowledge and understanding of place value. They will then spend time further developing their mental and written methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. As well as this, they will continue to work on their Maths Passport.



Science



Our focus for the term will be on the human body. The aim is to investigate how the different parts of the circulatory system work. Children will explore how a healthy lifestyle supports the body to function and how different types of drugs affect the body.

Computing
