We are delighted that all accepted images will be displayed at the new Chapel Arts, Knapp Road (near St James Square) Cheltenham GL50 3QQ towards the end of April alongside the Annual Exhibition of the Cheltenham Camera Club. Awards for the winning images and best Primary and Secondary School Entries will be presented at the Opening Ceremony. The date of the Exhibition will be announced shortly.

Entry is very simple - A pupil can enter one image up to A4 on any subject. Images do not have to be printed on photographic paper – it is the image that counts. All pictures must be titled and have the pupil's name on the back. First prize for the individual winner is £70.
