Twiglets at Twilight, will start on 24th April

We are pleased to announce that our new after school provision, Twiglets at Twilight, will start on 24th April, our first Monday back. Twiglets will be run by Mr Knight and Mrs Wilmott from 3:15pm to 6pm each school day. No doubt Mr Knight will make use of the outdoor learning environment whether this is through sports and fitness activities or in the Forest School area. There will also be the opportunity for children to complete any homework that has been set in a quiet space and there will be plenty of opportunities for the children to be creative. The cost of the provision will be £8 for the session, regardless of whether your child/children attend an after school activity first or whether they will be collected early, and will include a healthy afternoon tea. The afternoon tea will comprise of sandwiches, fruit/vegetables, a drink and a slice of tray bake, all provided by Caterlink.
