ParentPay – Secondary Payer Account.

There is now the option in ParentPay for a secondary payer account to be added to a child's ParentPay account. This allows another person (with their own logon details) to pay for items for a child via ParentPay. This secondary payer can either have the ability to just make payments or to make payments and bookings. Free school meals - apply now! Calling all year 2's ready for year 3

Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, our school will received extra funding if your child is eligible. The new free school meals policy is as follows-

Children might be able to get free school meals if they or their parents get any of the following:

- * Income Support
- * income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- * income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- * support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- * the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- * Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- * Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- * Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Check to see if your child is eligible using the confidential online portal available on our website www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals You can secure a tasty free meal for your child and save yourself up to £437 per year. Plus your child's school receives extra funding for each abtille child recisiered.
