Gloucestershire Music (the Local Authority Music Service) has teamed up with BBC Radio Gloucestershire and Music for All to help you get creative and get playing. On Saturday 17th March, we will be holding a F.A.M.E. (First Access Music Ensembles) morning and would like to invite your family to attend. All members of your family (aged 7 and above and adults) will be able to try a range of brass, string and woodwind instruments. This is part of a national 'learn to play weekend' held each year and promoted by Music for All (www.musicforall.org.uk). Parents and friends can join in and GM will be able to sign post you to our adult Learn As You Play programme and choirs. There are 100 places up for grabs so be quick.

Where and when?

Our FA.M.E. morning will be held on Saturday 17th March at two of our Music Centres. **Brookfield Music Centre** (Gloucester) - Sir Thomas Rich's School, Oakleaze, Gloucester, GL2 OLF.

Five Valleys Music Centre (Stroud) – Archway School, Pagan Hill, Stroud, GL5 4AX.

09:30 - 11:30 Meet the team and try the instruments.

12:00 - 12:30 Performance from the Music Centre Orchestra.

Our F.A.M.E. day will give you and your child(ren) the chance to try a range of instruments (brass, strings and woodwind) and *fast track* them ready to join the music centre of their choice in April. When they have chosen the instrument they like, your child will be provided with lessons at one of our two F.A.M.E. Academies that take place at Brookfield and Five Valleys Music Centre. Lessons are held between 10:40 - 11:15 each Saturday as part of the Music Centre's timetable of activities.

instrument hire and lessons.

Our F.A.M.E day is free (thanks to the support from Music for All). If you decide to attend one of our centres, we will provide you the chance to hire an instrument. Instrument hire ranges from £11.60 - £26.90 with bursaries available. F.A.M.E. lessons are then offered free of charge for a limited period of time (for young people) until you progress to full music centre membership (see our website for details and costs). We can also signpost adults to our Learn As You Play centres in Stroud and Cheltenham.
