

## Activity Week at Morfa Bay Outdoor Centre

21<sup>st</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> September 2026

Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child will begin Year 6 with the opportunity to take part in a fun-filled, adventurous week of outdoor pursuits in Morfa Bay, South Wales. During this week the children take part in a range of activities including abseiling, surfing, mountain biking, assault course and archery. In the evenings they enjoy a night hike and spending time on the beautiful beaches. We encourage all children to take part in this residential trip as it helps develop their confidence, teamwork and social skills.

If you would like your child to take part, the cost will be approximately £390 to cover the cost of the activities, transport and board and lodgings for the week. If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals, we ask for a reduced contribution of approximately £223.

Payment is required for children to be able to take part in this optional extra activity. We don't yet have a confirmed cost of the trip but we expect it to be very similar to last year and we understand it will be helpful to parents if the cost of the trip can be spread over as many months as possible.

Therefore, we have set up a 26\_27 Year 6 Morfa Bay Trip – Initial Payments trip on Arbor. Please indicate whether or not your child will be participating in this trip by paying a deposit of £80.00 (£40 FSM pupils) by the end of March 2026 and further payments up to £200 (£123 FSM pupils) by the end of May. We will confirm the exact cost of this trip as soon as possible with the remainder of the payments being due between June and September. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals and you are concerned about the affordability of this trip, please contact the School Office to arrange to discuss this with Mrs Woolley.

Payments should be made through Arbor but if you cannot make payments online please let Mrs Glover know in the School Office and she can discuss options to pay in cash/bank card.
