Our topic this term is 'Discovery'.

Spellings

Weekly spellings will begin week commencing 15th of September. Towards the end of the term, we will also introduce Maths Homework.

Reading

Essential Letters and Sounds (ELS) is our phonics scheme. Year 1 will be completing Phase 5 of the ELS scheme and will continue to bring home a decodable text. Year 2 will now complete the ELS Spelling unit. This will continue to support their phonics knowledge as well as giving them the confidence to apply this to their spelling. To begin with, your child will be bringing home 2 books each week- a decodable (phonics) book and a reading for pleasure book. Once the children have been assessed on Accelerated Reader, this process may change. More information will be provided at this time.
