



English



During the final terms of this year, we will be securing our learning of skills and using these in our writing. We will do this through quality texts such as Jonny Duddle's, Giganotosaurus and Dinosaur Lady by Linda Skeers. Later in the term, we will be designing our own shape poems using the texts 'Apes to Zebras' to explore this. Finally, we will be promoting work on spelling ensuring all the Year 2 common exception words are being consistently spelt correctly.



Maths



Throughout the first few weeks, we will continue to look at multiplication and division. After, the children will complete & consolidate their learning of measurement, before moving on to comparing the mass of different objects. This will then lead on to a short unit on capacity, using an array of measuring containers. Following this, the children will begin their learning of fractions where we will dive into recognising halves and quarters and thirds of numbers and shapes.



Science



PLANTS

Throughout this term, we will be observing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will discover and identify all the things that plants need to stay healthy and survive to answer the question: 'What makes a suitable environment for plants to grow?'

We will record our findings and discuss patterns. Our previous learning about keeping animals fit and healthy will help with this.

We will review our knowledge of the 5 oceans of the world and the seas surrounding the UK. We will identify coastal areas and find them on maps and in atlases. We will look at human & physical features of coastal regions.
