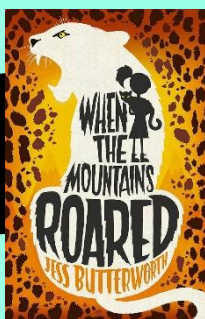

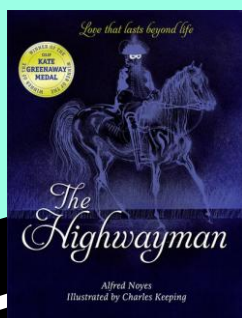


READING FOR PLEASURE
We will read *When the Mountains Roared* by Jess Butterworth as our class reader.

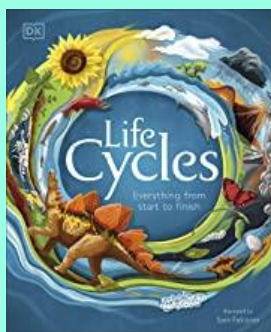


This interactive text, *Spin to Survive Frozen Mountain* by Emily Hawkins, will provide stimulus for our instructions writing unit.

Everest by Alexandra Stewart will help us to understand what it is like to climb a mountain.



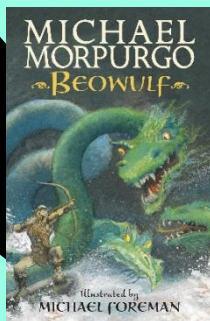
Life Cycles will help us achieve our outcomes in the wider curriculum by helping us to understand life cycles of plants and animals in science.

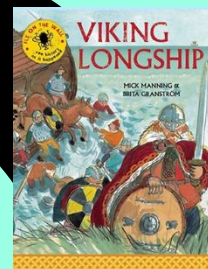
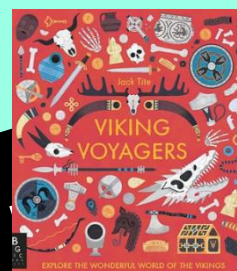
