Write a fact file about the life of Sir David Attenborough by researching his **early life, career and achievements**.

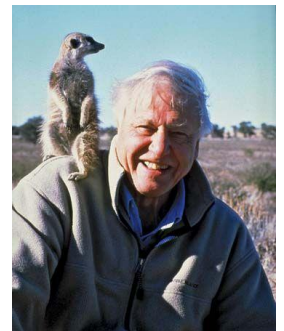
Think carefully about how you would like to present your fact file.

Due on Friday 22nd May

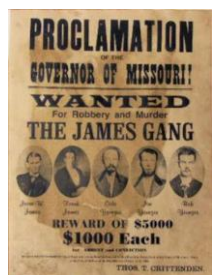
