Maths



In maths lessons, we will develop our knowledge of decimals and percentages, as well as our understanding of ratio, area, perimeter and volume. We will work on speeding up our arithmetic skills through Early Bird Maths sessions each morning.

In preparation for SATs in the summer term, we will also work on applying our knowledge to solving a wide range of problems.



Science



The Big Question: What is our Circulatory System and how does it work? During **Term 3**, we will learn about the heart, blood vessels and lungs and how they work together as our circulatory system.

The Big Question: How does light travel? During **Term 4**, we will learn about how light travels and how we see. We will investigate how light is reflected as well as how to change the size and shape of shadows.

Geography



Where does our energy come from?

In **Term 3**, we will look at renewable and non-renewable energy, where it comes from and how it gets to us. We will consider the benefits and drawbacks of different energy sources.
