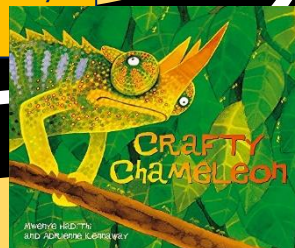
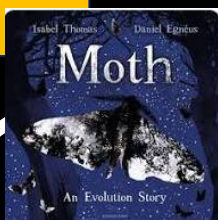
READING FOR PLEASURE
We will finish reading The Bletchley Riddle followed by King of Nothing. This book will be shared, discussed and used in guided reading lessons.



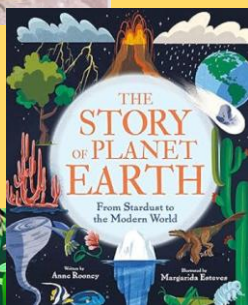
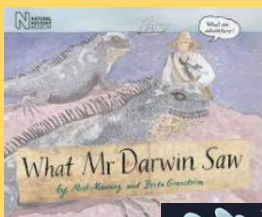

These texts will help us achieve our outcomes in the wider environment-learning about Evolution in Science.

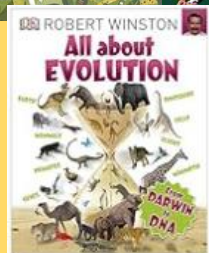


Who was Charles Darwin? We will support our learning in Science and the wider curriculum to research people who have made amazing discoveries and shown enormous **courage and curiosity**.
