Welcome back to the Summer term of Year 4&5. We hope you all had a lovely Easter break and are looking forward to getting stuck into our final two terms!

During Term 5, our geography learning will be about rivers and how are they formed. We will explore the features of a river and improve our understanding of a local river, focusing on the River Severn. Across the school in term 6, we take the opportunity to delve into the history of Tetbury. This year, we will focus on how the railway transformed Tetbury, including a trip to The Goods Shed. Please can children always have a full school PE kit in school so that we are able to practise for sports events, such as District Sports and our annual Sports Day, whenever possible.

It is important that your child is continuing to practise rapid recall of times tables and mental maths facts as well as reading every day. Remember to record in your reading journal to collect those stars - one for every two reads!

Y4s: By the end of Year 4 there is the expectation that the children will be able to recall all times table facts to 12x12. This is checked through the Multiplication Table Check, which is statutory for all Year 4 children. To help your child prepare, it is crucial that they are practising times tables regularly using TTRS or Maths Frame.
