

## Year Six Homework Tasks

### Autumn Term 2022

All children are expected to:

- practice spellings each week in preparation for a test/check each Friday
- read regularly – at least 3 times per week – to an adult (to develop fluency and expression)

In addition, here are some more tasks to support your learning in our Geography and History topics this term:

Task	Hand-in date
RE: In RE, we are comparing the Creation story from Genesis with the scientific theory of 'Big Bang'. Your task is to create either a 2-d picture or 3-d representation of an aspect of either the bible story OR the scientific theory. You may want to pick a day from the bible story, or create a 'Big Bang' using collage materials/ paint etc. Get creative!	Friday 23 <sup>rd</sup> September
Science: As part of our Science work on classification, your task is to research an animal classified as either a reptile, an amphibian or a mammal. Gather lots of information – its habitat, diet, body features (including what makes it reptile/amphibian/mammal). Present your information in an interesting way – and remember, presentation is important so make your sentences clear.	Friday 14 <sup>th</sup> October
History: As part of our work on Ancient Greece, your task is to research Greek recipes and make/bake the recipe. Bring your food into school on this Friday so we can have a 'class share'. <b><u>Please ensure you label your food with the ingredients so we can check for allergies.</u></b> I'm looking forward to this feast!	Friday 4 <sup>th</sup> November
History: Design a Greek board game. It could be based on a Greek battle (you'll need to do some research) or it could be based on a Greek myth such as Odysseus and the Cyclops. It's up to you! Bring them in and we will have a class session playing them together.	Friday 25 <sup>th</sup> November
History: Design your own Greek God. What did they look like? Who were they related to? What were they in charge of? Draw and label your Greek God.	Friday 9 <sup>th</sup> December
