Welcome back to Term 3 of Year Four. I hope you had a lovely Christmas break and wish you all a happy new year.

Our Geography focus this term is, 'Where does our food come from?' We will learn about where food is imported from, fair trade with a specific focus on Côte d'Ivoire and cocoa beans. They will explore where the food for their school dinners comes from and the pros and cons of local versus global. Our History focus in term 4 will be the Ancient Greek civilisation and how it has influenced our world day.

We will be having our **weekly spelling check every Friday**. The children will have brought home their list of words for term 3 to learn for homework. These can also be found on your child's journal on SEESAW.

By the end of Year 4 there is the expectation that the children will be able to **recall all times table facts to 12x12**. Websites to help practise times tables are on SEESAW and inside their homework books. These will help your child to prepare for the *Year 4 Multiplication Table Check*, which is statutory for all primary schools in June 2023.

Please encourage and support your child to learn their weekly spellings and times table facts.

Forest School will start on Friday 6th January for 5 weeks. Please send your child to school dressed in warm Forest School clothes and bring their school uniform in a plastic bag to change into after our session.

Gentle reminder: for a breaktime snack, children should bring extra fruit or vegetables rather than taking something from their lunch box.
