Phonics

We are continuing with our Phonics teaching – the children are now learning diagraphs which are two letters that make one sound e.g. "ck", "sh", "qu". They are all enjoying finding letters they have learnt wherever they go! We are also placing a lot of emphasis on reading and writing CVC words (Consonant-Vowel-Consonant) such as dog, pig, hat, tug etc. Harder to read words are being taught alongside so please keep practicing the sheets we gave you at Parents' Evening. 😊
