WRITE AN ACROSTIC POEM.



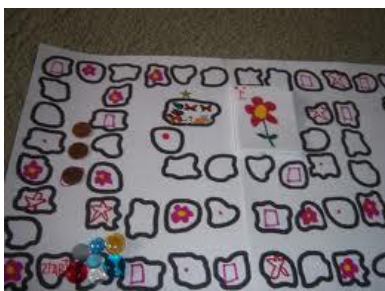
Use knowledge that you have learnt in *Geography* this term about Fairtrade and other information you can research to get **creative** and write a FAIRTRADE *acrostic poem*.
