

Gloucestershire Young Photographer of the Year 2018

Rules

1. This competition is open to pupils attending Gloucestershire schools.
2. Awards will be made for individual photographs as well as for school entries in Primary and Secondary school categories (see 13. below for details).
3. Each pupil may submit **one unmounted** print, either in colour or black and white: minimum size 6"x4" (150 mm x 100 mm) and maximum size A4 (210mm x 300mm)
4. **The whole of the picture must have been photographed by the entrant and therefore be their copyright.**
5. The prints may be produced in the dark room, on a home computer, or commercially.
6. Each print should be marked on the back with the **title** of the photograph, **name of the photographer** and their **school**.
7. All entries should be accompanied by a correctly completed entry form (**one form per school**). This may be copied for additional entries. It is especially important to include titles.
8. The entries must reach the address below by **Friday 23rd March 2018**

9. The photographs will be judged by a panel of three judges chosen by Cheltenham Camera Club.
10. Winners will be notified during April 2018 and results will be published on the Club's website www.cheltenhamcameraclub.co.uk later that month.
11. The judges' decision will be final.
12. The winning entries, and any other photographs selected by the judges, will be exhibited at Cheltenham Camera Club's Annual Exhibition at Chapel Arts, Knapp Road, Cheltenham, GL50 3QQ. The prizes will be presented at the opening of the Exhibition. The dates of the Ceremony and Exhibition, which will be towards the end of April, will be announced shortly.
13. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed photographs in both the Secondary and Primary school categories; other photographs may be 'Highly Commended' or 'Commended'. Trophies will also be awarded to the Primary and Secondary Schools with the best entries.
14. Any photograph may be used for publicity purposes by Cheltenham Camera Club.
15. Whilst every care will be taken, the Club cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to entries or for the infringement of any copyright.

A stamped addressed envelope must be enclosed with the entry, for return of photographs and certificates awarded.
