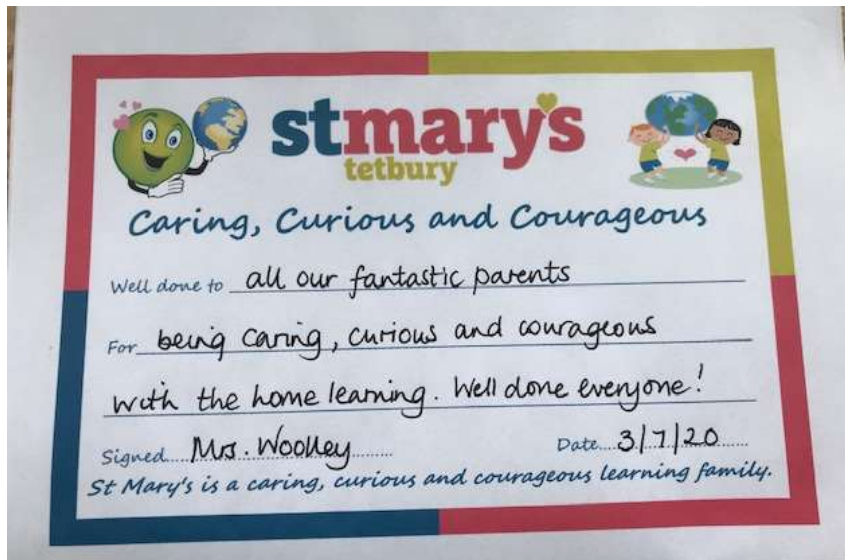
Remote learning: Years 2- 5

For the final two weeks of term we are increasing the number of eligible children we have in school by opening up another 'bubble' and re-organising staffing. Children who are eligible to attend school include: Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 pupils, children of key workers and children who have been assessed as being vulnerable.

I have therefore asked the Y2 – Y5 teachers to increase their contact time in school in order to teach the increasing number of children attending school. The class teachers will still be setting work on Seesaw for children learning at home, however you may notice that they are not responding to children's work throughout the day as much as they will be in school teaching the eligible children in their year groups for a larger part of the week.

I am aware as we approach the end of the school year that some parents are struggling to keep the children's enthusiasm going and the teachers will do their best to keep the children engaged.
