We are delighted to inform you that after this very strange year, we have organised to take the Year 6 children to Bowood House and Gardens for their Leavers' event. We will take a coach there on **Wednesday 14**th **July** within normal school hours.

At Bowood House and Gardens, the children will be able to enjoy a range of activities: from walking above the treetops on a series of ariel walkways to pushing themselves to new heights and taking the plunge down the famous 19ft vertical Space Dive. The playground is also equipped with balance beams, boat swings, trampolines and climbing frames. There is also a life size pirate ship to play on and an ice cave to visit.
