Coronavirus Update

As we approach the end of term, I wanted to write to give you some guidance on what to do if your child tests positive for Coronavirus in the first week of the holidays.

My child has tested positive over the <u>weekend of 19th & 20th December</u> – who should I inform?

If your child tests positive for Coronavirus and symptoms developed over the first weekend of the holidays (19th and 20th December) you must inform the school of the positive test.

If your child tests positive for Coronavirus over the first weekend of the holidays and has not developed symptoms you must also inform the school.

My child has tested positive after the first weekend of the holidays – who should I inform?

If your child tests positive for Coronavirus after the first weekend (from the 21st December – 24th December) you should email or telephone the Local Authority on:

The Local Authority will then contact the school.

Parents and carers should also follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS test and trace.
