

Year 4 visit to the Ashmolean Museum

Dear Parents and Carers



As part of our topic *Pharaoh Nuff*, we are visiting the Ashmolean Museum in Oxford on **Tuesday 19th November**. The children will enjoy exploring the Egyptian Galleries and a museum led interactive workshop will enhance their learning.

We will travel by coach, leaving school earlier than other school trips due to the amount of traffic in Oxford at the time we will be arriving. Therefore the children need to be in school for **8.30am**. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause but we want the children to get the most out of the day. Similarly we may be a little later returning to school - we will confirm nearer the time when we expect to be back.

To help fund the day we are asking for a voluntary payment of £9 per child to be paid by ParentPay. If not possible, please pay by cheque payable to Tetbury St Marys School Fund or cash in a named envelope. The children will need to wear school uniform and bring a coat. They will also need a packed lunch, including a drink. Packed lunches will be provided by the school for those children eligible for free school meals.
