# Onsite provision for children of critical workers and vulnerable pupils

Onsite provision for the children of critical workers will commence on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January. As you will know from my previous communication, children who are attending education onsite will need to attend Monday – Friday lunchtime. During the last lockdown we allowed parents to choose which days to send their children into school however this created daily organisational challenges and disrupted the learning of pupils.

The school will continue to implement systems of protective measures to ensure any risks are well managed and controlled.

### Breakfast Club and after school club

Breakfast club will run from 8am - 8.45am. Twiglets (after school club) will run from 3.15 - 5pm. Breakfast club will be £3 per session and Twiglets will be £7 per session. There is unlikely to be any facility to provide tea for the children who attend after school club. Parents may wish to pack a snack if children are staying until 5pm.

As previously, staff will keep children from different bubbles socially distanced.

The office has cancelled all previous bookings. If you wish to use Breakfast Club or Twiglets from Thursday please rebook the sessions you require.

Please note that the school will close to all pupils at 12.30pm on Fridays to allow teachers to complete planning and preparation. Children can still order a school packed lunch on a Friday, via ParentPay, but they bring it home with them to eat at home.

All children must wear school uniform and bring a water bottle, coat, wellies and trainers/plimsolls.



Children will be taught in year group bubbles by the staff from that year group. These staff will change throughout the week as teachers will be providing remote learning for their usual classes as well as face to face teaching throughout the week.

# Lunches

A packed lunch will be provided free of charge to infant pupils if required. Please book via ParentPay in the usual way.

Children who are entitled to benefits-related free school meals will also be provided with a school packed lunch. Please book the choice of sandwich filling via ParentPay.

All other children should bring a packed lunch to school including a water bottle for the day.

#### Lessons

Children will be accessing the remote learning set by the teachers as well as doing physical activity and creative projects.
