As part of our geography work on National Parks this term, we have arranged an exciting day visit to Pen-y-Fan, in the Brecon Beacons, on Thursday 17th October. We will be based at the Storey Arms Outdoor Education Centre and the children will take part in a range of exciting activities linked to the National Park.

We will leave by coach at 8am so children will need to arrive at school by 7.50am.

As the Brecons are a fair distance away and in order to help the children get the most out of the visit, we will leave the Education Centre at 3pm, returning to school around **5pm**.

Children will need:

Warm outdoor clothing - not school uniform (plenty of layers please)

- A packed lunch and drink (Packed lunches will be provided for those who receive a free school meal please indicate below ham, cheese, tuna or egg)
- Waterproof coat and waterproof trousers (the centre we are visiting will have some spares if absolutely necessary)
