Welcome back to Term 3 of Year Four. We hope you had a lovely Christmas break and we wish you all a happy new year.

Our **Geography focus** this term is, 'Where does our food come from?' We will learn about where food is imported from, fair trade with a specific focus on Côte d'Ivoire and cocoa beans. They will explore where the food for their school dinners comes from and the pros and cons of local versus global. Our History focus in term 4 will be the Ancient Greek civilisation and how it has influenced our world day.

By the end of Year 4 there is the expectation that the children will be able to **recall all times table facts to 12x12**.
