Flu Immunisation - important information action required

This year's flu immunisation programme will take place for all years on Monday 30TH November, Tuesday 1st December and Wednesday 2nd December. We have today had an update from the Immunisation team, if you have already had your child immunised this year, please can you email the school office with this information asap with your childs name, class and confirmation that your child has already been immunised. If you have previously told the office, please email with this information again to clarify in writing, as well as declining on the online NHS immunisation portal.

If you have not already confirmed or declined, it is really important that you do so as soon as possible, as the portal will be closing very soon. This will eliminate any delays regarding administering the vaccine on the days of immunisation.






Children in Need


Thank you to everyone who contributed towards the Children in need fundraising last week. The school raised a grand total of £361!


Christmas Packed lunch - don't forget to book you lunch online through parent pay
