Task 1:

RESEARCH A EUROPEAN RIVER



To support our learning in *Geography*, we would like you to choose any river in Europe, but **NOT one in the UK**, and create a fact file based on your research. You should include information such as; the name of the river, location of the source of the river, location of the end of the river, length/ width, map of the river. You might also find out about animals or plants that live in/ near to the river and how the river is used.

Some examples of rivers are: Danube River, Seine River or the Rhine river.

Task 2:

ANIMAL MASK

During Term 6, our Science topic will be Living things and their habitats. We will specifically be looking at classification of animals. To show case our learning, we would like you to choose a particular animal group and create a mask based on that animal. **Can you tell us features of your animal, that might help us classify it?**
