

During this term, we will be writing to entertain and inform through a range of texts both fiction and non fiction. These texts will be based around our historical learning of the famous, 'Florence Nightingale' and her achievements. We will be writing in full sentences that make sense using adjectives and correct punctuation. We will be putting emphasis on spelling the year 1 & 2 high frequency words (found on our website) correctly. Each day the children will be practising their handwriting - letter formation and sizing. Please continue to support your children by encouraging them to read frequently.

Geography WOULD YOU PREFER TO LIVE IN A HOT OR COLD PLACE?

In geography, we will be identifying and naming the worlds 7 continents. We will also locate the poles and equator and talk about the climates. The children will compare life and climate in Kenya to the UK.

Computing

The children will start with a lesson learning about online safety before learning how to create and debug algorithms. We will decompose games using the 'Scratch' software.

Music

The children will listen to and appraise different songs. They will learn a song as a class and accompany the music using glockenspiels.

Maths

Throughout the first term, the children will consolidate their knowledge of addition and subtraction of larger numbers using the partitioning method. In term 4 we will be looking at shape and money. The children will be able to idenfity 2D/3D shapes, recognise coins/notes and begin to make change with them. Then we will move onto multiplication and division. We will be using maths resources such as counters and blocks to support us in creating practical representations.
