be one of our main class texts.

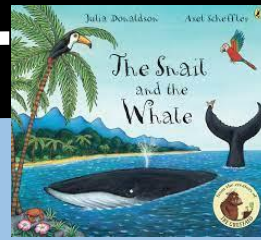

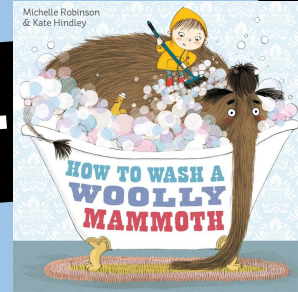
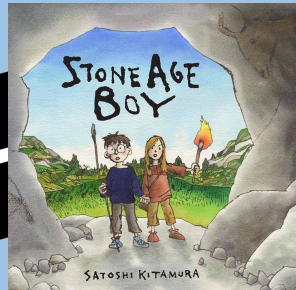


READING FOR PLEASURE

In term 2, Ug: Boy Genius of the Stone Age and other Stone age themed texts as stimulae for writing..

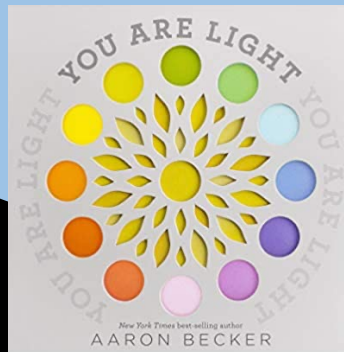


These two texts will be used in Guided Reading to help enrich our learning in Geography all about the counties of the United Kingdom.

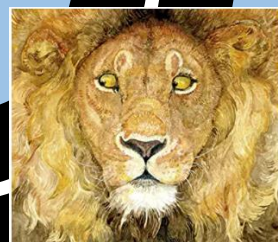
READING FOR PLEASURE
We will enjoy reading **Secrets of a Sun King** by the popular author, Emma Carroll. This is our class reader, linking perfectly to our topic.



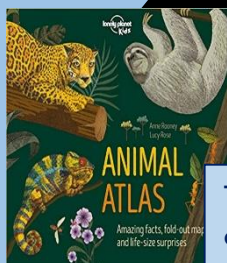
The Egyptian Cinderella by Shirley Climo will provide us with stimuli for our narrative writing unit and will be used in guided-reading.

The Lion and The Mouse by Jerry Pinkney... A stunning, wordless version of one of Aesop's best-loved fables offering huge scope to help us retell the fable.

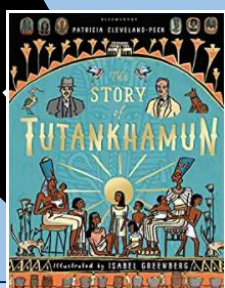


This text will help us achieve our outcomes in the wider curriculum – understanding and describing key features of rainforests and locating the continents of the world.

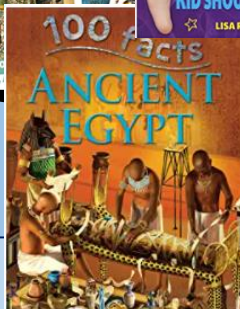
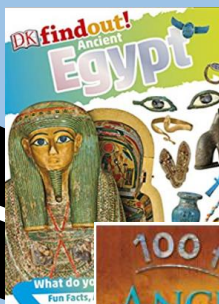

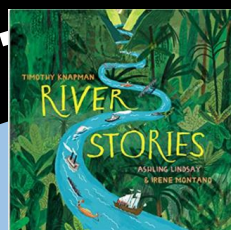

The Story of Tutankhamun by Patricia Cleveland-Peck will help us with our non-fiction writing and study of the Egyptians.

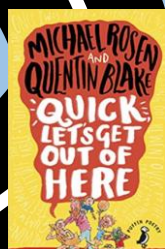


These are some of the other non-fiction texts which will enrich our History and Science learning.

Year 4 will read, enjoy and perform a variety of poems this term.

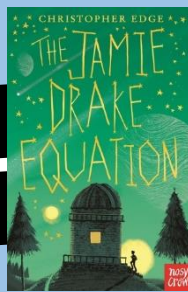




Discovery: Our Planet Earth & Space



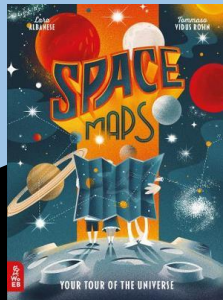
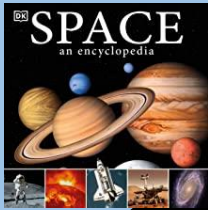
After The Fall by Dan Santat is our whole school text. All classes will read and share this book during the first week of term, focusing on courage, resilience and overcoming fears.

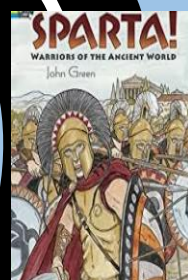
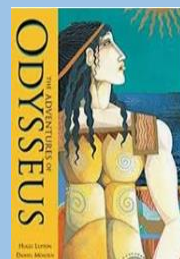


After the Fall by Dan Santat will be studied by classes across the school. It is all about resilience – a key part of learning!

We will read Holes or There's a Boy in the Girls' bathroom by Louis Sachar. These books will provide stimulus for writing to discuss and will be used in guided reading.

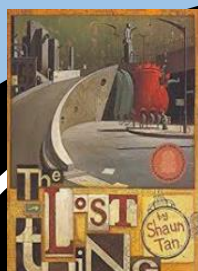
The Adventures of Odysseus is our core novel. It will provide stimulus for our narrative writing unit.



Mythologica and Sparta are non-fiction books which will provide stimulus for our non-fiction writing units.



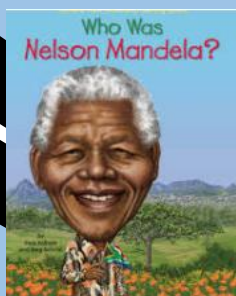
Quest by Aron Becker and The Lost Thing by Shaun Tan will form the basis of our second narrative unit of writing.



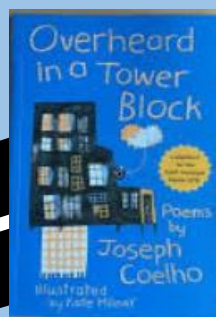
This is one of four texts that will be used across the whole school during Remembrance Week. Writing outcomes will be based on this text.
