

Minoan Age 2000 BC - 1450 BC	The first Greek civilisation was very advanced.
Mycenaean Age 1450 BC- 1100 BC	Prided themselves on being protected from war.
Dark Ages 1100 BC- 800 BC	Very little evidence is recorded from this period.
Archaic Period 800 BC- 480 BC	The first OLYMPIC GAMES took place in 776 BC in honour of the God Zeus.
Classical Period 480 BC- 323 BC	Democracy was introduced and the Parthenon was built in honour of the God Athena.
Peloponnesian War 431 BC- 404 BC	Peloponnesian War between Athens and Sparta (Sparta is victorious).
Alexander the Great 336 BC- 323 BC	He ruled Ancient Greece for the period and never lost a single battle as he gained much of Europe and Asia.
Hellenistic Period 323 BC- 146 BC	There was constant fighting after the King's death between different cities.
Romans Conquer Greece 146 BC	The Greek civilisation began to decline and Greece was conquered by the Romans.

DEMOCRACY VS. MONARCHY

Within Ancient Greece city states had different types of Governments. Corinth had a government run by the Monarchy meaning the King decided what happened. Athens had a democratic government. Each year, new people were chosen to form a government and rule the country.

Democracy	People have the right to vote for laws and rules.
Scholars	A person who is highly educated in a subject e.g. Science
City States	Small areas that Ancient Greece was divided into, with their own laws and armies.
Empire	A group of countries ruled by one ruler.
Legacy	Still exists after an event ends.
Monarchy	King or Queen as ruler of a country.
