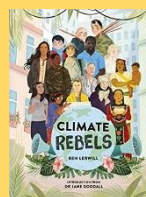
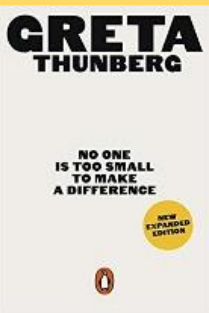
READING FOR PLEASURE

These books will inform our non-fiction writing through learning about Greta Thunberg. We will write speeches inspiring **courage** and **caring** for our world.

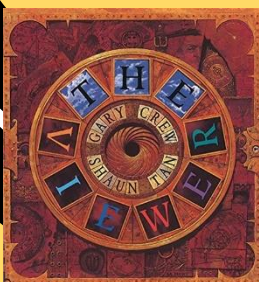

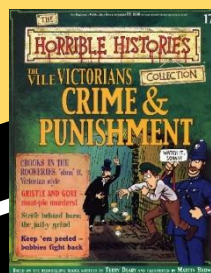
