English

During this term, we will be writing to entertain and inform through a range of texts. We will be developing descriptive language and using features of information texts as well as using poetic language effectively. Spelling lessons will take place each week and the children will enjoy reading our class book as well as sharing texts in Guided Reading. Please continue to support your children by encouraging them to read frequently.

Geography



Earthquakes and Volcanoes: Why do people live near volcanoes?

In geography, we will be explaining why volcanoes happen and where they occur and recognise the positive and negative effects of living near one. Moving onto studying what earthquakes are and why they occur.

Computing

The children will recap E safety before Exploring spreadsheets. The children will aim to create pie charts and bar graphs by inserting data into a cell.

Music

The children will listen to, appraise and learn a range of songs. They will accompany the music using glockenspiels.



Maths

In maths lessons, the children will continue multiplication and division, how to exchange and partition numbers. We will be looking at length and perimeter by adding and subtracting different measurements and developing their knowledge of fractions. We will continue to develop their addition, and subtraction skills and apply their knowledge to a variety of problems. The children will also continue daily work on their times tables and arithmetic skills through Early Bird Maths.



PE

Our lessons will focus on coordination and using a range of gym equipment. During the term, coaches from FGR will be teaching us a range of football skills.

During the term we will be exploring the big guestions:

- 1) How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?
- 2)How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jewish people.



Science




Rock 'n' Roll
