

English



During this term, we will be writing to entertain and inform through a range of texts. We will be developing our writing using speech and inverted commas. We will be writing a newspaper report to inform as well as using poetic language effectively. Spelling lessons will take place each week and the children will enjoy reading our class book as well as sharing texts in Guided Reading. Please continue to support your children by encouraging them to read frequently.

Geography: THE EARTH BENEATH OUR FEET

Where does our food come from?

In geography, we will be studying where different foods are imported from in relation to the world's biomes. Children will learn about fair trade with a specific focus on Côte d'Ivoire and cocoa beans.

Computing

The children will start with a lesson learning about online safety before developing their coding skills.



Maths



In maths lessons, the children will explore: written methods of multiplying and dividing 2 and 3-digit numbers by 1 digit; find the length and perimeter of shapes; explore different representations of fractions as well as compare and find fractions that are equivalent and fractions that represent tenths and hundredths.

The children will also continue daily work on their times tables and arithmetic skills through Early Bird Maths.

CHANGES OF MATERIALS: What are the properties of different materials and how do they change?

We will be identifying the three states of matter, making observations about changes in materials when heated and cooled and understanding the Water Cycle.

SOUND: How do we hear sounds? We will be identifying how sounds are made and finding patterns between pitch and volume of sound.

History: NEW HORIZONS ________. ANCIENT GREECE: How has Ancient Greece influenced our world today?

We will learn about who the ancient Greeks were and locate their civilisation on a timeline. We will explore and discuss democracy and how modern life has been influenced by the ancient Greeks.
