

Year 6 Homework Tasks

Summer Term 2023

All children are expected to:

- practice spellings each week in preparation for a test/check each Friday
- read regularly – at least 3 times per week – to an adult (to develop fluency and expression)
- practice times tables up to 12 x 12. These are so important across all aspects of mathematics

In addition, here are some more tasks to support your learning across our curriculum this term. There are only three for the summer term. This is because we will have lots to learn for our summer play – details to follow after SATs week!!

Task	Hand-in date
English biography: We will be writing biographies this term. Find out about a person that you admire or aspire to be like. It may be someone in your family, a famous musician or sports star, anybody really! Find out about their early life; what may have inspired them to do what they do; interesting things about them. Present it in an interesting way!	Friday 5 th May
Science: As part of our Science work on evolution, inheritance and adaptation, we would like you to research a favourite animal you may have or one you find particularly interesting. Create a page of information to explain how that animal is adapted to its environment, Think about the appearance (camouflage, for example), diet and habitat.	Friday 26 th May
Reading: This year, you will have hopefully read several books and heard many being read in class as part of guided reading or reading for pleasure (such as The Silver Sword). Your task is to choose one of your favourites and design a poster to advertise the book. Think about who it might appeal to, what aspects of the story they might like and what images you could include to make it really eye-catching!	Friday 23 rd June
