

Maths We will continue to follow the 'White Rose' maths scheme by comparing numbers to 5, composition of 4 and 5, comparing mass and capacity. We will be counting to 6,7 and 8, making pairs and combining 2 groups. We will continue to use songs and actions to count forwards and backwards to 20.



Religious Education

This term we are learning about why the word 'God' so important to Christians and who is God? We will use the story of Creation to help answer these questions. Our Christian value this term is 'Curiosity' which links to our school 3Cs.



Literacy

We will be continuing to develop our reading and writing skills through RWI each day. This term we are studying the stories of Max and Supertato. We will use the texts to investigate character descriptions and sequence events in order to retell the stories. We will also be writing fact files about real life superheroes.



Communication & Language

The children will be listening to a range of stories, sequencing events and retelling stories. We will continue to practice our listening skills and focus on taking turns in a conversation via our Teams meetings.
