

**Maths** We will continue to follow the 'White Rose' maths scheme by exploring 3D shapes and numbers beyond 10. We will use short stories to explain adding on and taking away using vocabulary such as 'first, then and now'. We will continue to use Early Bird Maths every morning to help us consolidate learning so far and address any misconceptions.



### Literacy

We will be further developing our reading and writing skills through Read Write Inc lessons each day. We will use core texts and stories to investigate characteristics and facts, to help us write our own class book.

### Communication & Language

The children will be listening to a wide range of stories, sharing their knowledge with others and continuing to practice their listening and turn taking skills to hold a conversation.

### Religious Education

This term we are learning all about Special places. This will include recognising places that carry a special meaning to people who are religious. Our Christian value this term is 'Courage' which links to our school 3Cs.

### Understanding the World

Through our weekly welly walks, we will be investigating our outdoor areas by looking for changes in the school environment, signs of new life, growth and patterns in nature. We will recreate some of these patterns using Andy Goldsworthy for inspiration.



### Personal, Social, Emotional Development

Our topic is "Relationships" and this term we will be learning all about our relationships with other people. This will include talking about our families, friends, falling out and how to be the best friend we can be.



### Expressive Art and Design

This term we will be using our design and technology skills to make a crocodile, practicing our drawing skills and thinking carefully about different techniques we can use for different effects on the paper. We will be considering careful use of colour to make our pictures look more realistic. We will continue to enjoy listening to music, singing songs and engaging in role play.

### Physical Development

Children will continue to develop their fine motor skills through 'funky fingers' activities and specific handwriting letter and pattern practice. In PE we will be improving our coordination skills using the Jasmine PE scheme. We will focus on sending and receiving objects such as balls and bean bags. We also focus on performing skills and movements under more control.
